# NABL ACCREDITATION CHECKLIST





### **MUST-HAVE INFRASTRUCTURE**

To meet NABL requirements, your lab must be equipped with the following:

- Controlled environment (temperature, humidity, ventilation)
- Proper electrical wiring with UPS and backup power
- Isolated clean areas for different processes
- Certified and calibrated instruments
- Safety equipment (PPE, fire extinguisher, first-aid kit)
- Secure storage for samples, reagents, and chemicals
- Qualified technical personnel and clearly defined organizational hierarchy

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

A complete NABL submission includes the following documents:

- Quality Manual as per ISO/IEC 17025 or ISO 15189
- Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Equipment calibration certificates
- Internal audit reports
- Training records of lab personnel
- Proficiency testing participation records
- Risk assessment and corrective action plans
- Sample test reports
- Management review meeting minutes

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### **NABL AUDIT STAGES**

The NABL audit process consists of the following steps:

- 1. Application submission and document review
- 2. Pre-assessment audit (optional)
- 3. Final assessment by NABL assessors
- 4. Reporting of findings (non-conformities if any)
- 5. Submission of corrective actions by the lab
- 6. NABL review committee decision
- 7. Issuance of accreditation certificate
- 8. Surveillance audits every 12-18 months

### **CAPA DOCUMENTATION**

Corrective and Preventive Action (CAPA) must include:

- Identification of the non-conformity
- Root cause analysis
- Immediate corrective actions
- Long-term preventive actions
- Verification of effectiveness
- Updated documentation and training logs

Ensure CAPA records are signed, dated, and version-controlled.

## TIPS FROM SUCCESSFUL AUDITS

Here's what top-performing labs do to ace NABL audits:

- Keep documentation updated and accessible
- Conduct regular internal audits and mock assessments
- Maintain calibration traceability for all equipment
- Ensure staff are trained and aware of their roles
- Address even minor non-conformities proactively
- Be transparent with assessors and provide honest responses
- Have a dedicated compliance manager or team
