

Collection & PRO Tie-Up Requirements (EPR Compliance India)

To meet Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) compliance in India, businesses must establish a collection and disposal mechanism through a registered Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO). Below is a structured checklist and guidance on what is required to set up compliant PRO partnerships and collection systems.

1. Documents Required from PRO

- Certificate of Registration from CPCB/State Pollution Control Board
- MOA/Company Incorporation Document of PRO
- Waste Category Authorization Letter (e.g., plastic, e-waste, battery)
- Recycler Partnerships and MoUs
- Recycling Infrastructure Proof (photos, licenses, capacity details)
- Annual Compliance Reports (past 2 years, if available)

2. Collection Mechanism Requirements

- Geo-tagged collection centers mapped to target states
- Waste pickup logistics plan with estimated timelines
- Categorized weight traceability matrix (SKU to waste output)
- Integration with CPCB Portal for online waste return reporting
- Signed collection target agreement (in MT/year)
- Reverse logistics SOP and transporter partnership proof

3. Brand Owner Responsibilities

- Enter into a formal MoU with selected PRO(s)
- Ensure monthly/quarterly data is shared with PRO
- Approve collection and recycling proof submissions
- Monitor recyclables against annual EPR targets
- Upload supporting documents on CPCB portal
